A Visit to the "Gippsland Vehicle Collection"

The Gippsland Vehicle Collection is located in Maffra about 3 hours east of Melbourne, it is housed in an old vegetable de-hydrating factory built during WW2 and is known as "The Maffra Shed". It covers around 2200 Square Metres and is well worth a visit.

Recently Majella and I took HCCV member and previous owner of our Super Snipe, John Mahony on a visit to Majella's mum, Bernice Lee's farm at Bushy Park near Maffra. John and Bernice have been family friends for many years, and it was a great chance to catch up.
