DURING OUR 8 MONTHS CARAVAN TRIP TO QUEENSLAND MY WIFE AND I DECIDED TO MAKE A SHORT VISIT TO OUR NEAREST FRIENDLY NEW NATION XX - PAPUA NEW GUINEA.

WE HAD SEVERAL REASONS FOR REACHING THIS DECISION: -

- 1) MY WIFE HAD NOT BEEN THERE THOUGH SHE HAD VISITED ABOUT 15 COUNTRIES ACCOMPANYING ME ON BUSINESS.
- 2) MY SISTER JEAN AND HER BUSBAND JIM WERE ABOUT TO RETIRE AFTER NEARLY 30 YEARS IN THE TROPICS.
- 3) I HAD A YEARNING TO REVISIT THE AREA WHERE I SPENT SO MUCH TIME HELPING DEFEND THIS COUNTRY OF OURS.
- 4) THE EXPERIENCE WOULD MAKE A NICE CHANGE FROM THE CARAVAN.

SO WE BOOKED OURSELVES ON QANTAS FROM BRISBANE TO PT. MORESBY. FINALLY WE TOOK OFF AND XX HAD A PLEASANT FLIGHT RIGHT ALONG THE BARRIER REEF AND ALL THE CORAL CAYS WHXX WHICH SHONE IN THE MORNING SUN LIKE JEWELS. AFTER 3 HOURS CODDLING BY THE HOSTESSES WE LANDED AT JACKSON AIRPORT IN PT. MORESBY. THIS NEW LANDING FIELD HAS BEEN FORMED IN MEMORY OF SQUADRON LEADER JACKSON AND THE OLD WAR-TIME STRIP RUNS ALONGSIDE BEING PRESERVED AS A MEMORIAL THOUGH NOT USED TODAY.

JIM AND JEAN WERE WAITING TO GREET US BUT WE COULD NOT LEAVE THE CUSTOMS AREA AS OUR GROG WAS NOWHERE TO BE SEEN (GLEN-FIDDITCH AT \$4-50 A KMXXK BOTTLE) BUT MY WIFE SPOTTED A DIRTY OLD CARDBOARD BOX GOING AROUND AND AROUND ON THE LUGGAGE CAROUSEL, LOOKED IN IT AND THERE IT WAS! SO WE ALL WITH OUR BAGS TOOK OFF AND CLIMBED ABOUT 350 FEET (104 METERS) TO THEIR HOME. THEIR HOME HAS A QUEST WING WHICH WAS GIVEN OVER TO US TOGETHER WITH DAILY HELP OF THE "HOUSE BOY" WHO MADE OUR BEDS, DID OUR LAUNDRY AND IRONING, CLEANED OUR SHOES PLUS EVERY OTHER CONCEIVABLE THING. THAT WAS LUXURY PLUS! MY SISTER ONLY HAD TO COOK AS THE BOY DID ALL THE VEGIES AND SET THE TABLE AND FINALLY WASHED UP WHILE JIM WAS CHIEF DISPENSER OF LIQUID REFRESHEMTN. THEY DRINK STUBBIES UP THERE AND WHEN ONE IS HANDED ONE IT IS ALWAYS IN A FOAM CONTAINER SO THE BOTTLE DOES NOT BECOME WARM.

PT. MORESBY IS DIFFERENT FROM 32 YEARS AGO AND HAS SOME FINE TALL BUILDINGS, CHURCHES, TRAVELODGE MOTEL, CLUBS FOR GENTLEMEN AND OTHER SORTSHIKKS BURNS PHILP, STEAMSHIPS AND CARPENTERS STORES, AMBASSADORS AND CONSULS PLACES, A VERY MODERN AIR NEW GUINEA BUILDING AND SEVERAL BANKS OF MODERN DESIGN. THE NEW BANK OF P.N.G. WHICH WAS NEARLY COMPLETED IS ADORNED ON THE OUTER WALLS WITH NATIVE MOTIFS AND LOOKS QUITE SPECTULAR.

TRANSPORT FOR THE LOCALS IS BY AIR CONDITIONED BUSSES (NO WINDOWS) AND FOR THE EX-PATRIATES MAINLY DATSUN, TOYOTA OR V.W. VEHICLES. I DIDN'T SPOT A HUMBER ANYWHERE THOUGH THERE WERE A FEW RANGE ROVERS. THOSE LOCALS WHO COULDN'T RAISE THE BUS FARE STRAGGLED ALONG THE ROADS WITH THE WOMEN, KIDS AND ENDLESS BARKING DOGS. SOME LED A PIG WITH A STRING TIED TO ITS FRONT LEFT LEG. PIGS ARE WORTH \$1000.00 EACH!

ONE DAY A DRIVER TOOK US FOR A DRIVE TO A PLACE CALLED SOGERI ABOUT 3500 FEET UP BEHIND MORESBY AND I SAW THE FAMILIAR KOKODA TRAIL WHERE IT STARTED. THE EK DRIVER CAME FROM THAT AREA, HAS AN ARTIFICAL LEFT LEG AND LIKE ME IS ALLOWED TO DRIVE AUTOMATICS ONLY - IN THIS CASE A NICE MAZDA. HE RECEIVED COMPENSATION FOR A EX ACCIDENT, BOUGHT A FARM WITH THE MONEY AND HAS HIS WIFE AND FAMILY GROWING VEGETABLES FOR THE MARKET WHILE HE IS A DRIVEN. HE PROUDLY SHOWED US THE SEVENTH DAY ADVENTIST SCHOOL HE ATTENDED AND I MUST SAY THE S.D.A. SCHOOLS WERE THE NEATEST MOST DISCIPLINED WE SAW IN P.N.G. ALL THE BOYS AND GIRLS WORE NEAT BLUE UNIFORMS.

FROM JIM'S KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERIENCE FROM SPENDING 6 MONTHS A YEAR "ON CIRCUIT" WE DREW UP A PLAN FOR MY WIFE AND I TO VISIT OTHER PARTS WHICH UNFORTUNATELY EXCLUDED BOUGAINVILLE BECAUSE OF THE COST OF AIR FARES. ARMED WITH OUR NOTES WE WENT TO AIR NEW GUINEA TO RIK PUT THE PLAN IN ACTION. WE WERE INTRODUCED TO A PAPUAN LADY WHO WAS NOT ONLY BEAUTIFULLY GROOMED BUT WELL EDUCATED AND SPOKE GOOD ENGLISH -AND EASY ON THE EYES. SHE ORGAINSED OUR FLIGHTS AND HOTELS AND PRESENTED US WITH A WELL LAJD OUT ITINERARY AND THE BILL. WE HAD TO PAY HIGHER FOR AIR FARES THAN IN AUSTRALIA AND THE HOTELS WERE ABOUT \$42 A NIGHT FOR A TWIN ROOM PLUS MEALS. THE STANDARD OF HOTELS WE HAD TO SELECT WAS VERY GOOD BUT THE ALTERNATIVES WERE NOT FOR US! ALL HOTELS HAD THEIR NATIVE HAWKERS HANGING ROUND TRYING TO SELL US CARVINGS. BEADS, PIG'S TUSK ETC. BUT WE WERE EXPENSED IN HANDLING THAT TYPE OF IRRITANT.

ANYWAY WE TOOK OFF FROM MORESBY WITH A MIXED LOAD OF PASSENGERS. BLACK, BROWN AND BRINDLE, STRING BAGS OF MIKKE VEGIES, MEAT ETC. BABIES, OLD AND YOUNG MEN AND MORTER AND THANK GOODNESS HE AN AUSSIE CAPTAIN AND NAVIGATOR BOOMD FOR RABAUT IN NEW BRITAIN. WE FLEW OVER THE OWEN STAMLEY RANGES WHICH THE WALL OF DIGGERS HAD STRUGGLED AND FOUGHT OVER ON FOUT ON PAST TO THE POPONDETTA THEN WE COULD SEE RABAUL HARBOUR AHEAD SURROUNDED 100 BY EXTINCT AND ACTIVE VOLCANOES. OUT IN THE HIDDLE OF THE HARBOUR ARE XMXXXXX TWO TINY PEAKS OF AN ISLAND WHICH SUNK IN A "QUAKE CALLED THE BEEHIVES" AND THAT IS JUST WHAT THEY LOOK LIKE FLYING OVER. WE ARRANGED OUR RABAUL VISIT TO EMAX COINCIDE WITH JIM ON CIRCUIT AND OVER THE WEEKEND DROVE ALL ROUND THE AREA, IN FACT MOST OF GAZELLE PENINSULA. THERE WE SAW ENDLESS ROWS OF COCONUT TREES, COCOA TREES AND LUSH VEGETABLE GARDENS ON ALL OF WHICH THE ECONOMY DEPENDS. WE ALSO WENT TO SEE THE MEMORIAL TO THE KEX COASTWATCHERS. THIS WAS ON A HIGH HILL COMMANDING RABAUL AND ITS HARBOUR AND STILL HAD STILL HADE CONTROL THE JAP MULTI A.A. GUNS AS THEY WERE 36 YEARS AGO TOGETHER WITH A DOWNWARDPOINTING 6" NAVAL GUN, A ZERO FIGHTER AND A 30ft KNEKY LOOKOUT TOWER. THE JAPS SURELY HAD THINGS COVERED FROM THERE. WE ALSO SAW THE JAPANESE ADMIRAL'S CONCRETE DUG-OUT, BUT MAKE UNFORTUNATELY DID NOT GET TO SEE HIS CRASHED BOMBER WHICH KILLED HIM. ON A DRIVE ROUND THE COAST XXMX JIM SHOWED US TUNNELS IN THE CLIFFS WHICH THE JAPS USED TO HIDE THEIR LANDING BARGES AND EVEN TODAY THEY CONTAIN STEEL BARGES ON RAILWAY LINES WHICH KAN UP FROM HE BEACH. SHORTLY AFTER WE CAME UPON A FAMILY OF NATIVES WALKING ALONG THE ROAD IN SINGLE FILE WITH THE HEAL OF THE FAMILY CARRYING A STICK, HIS WIFE CARRYING A "BILLEN" BAG (STRING) SO FULL I COULD NOT LIFT IT, AND THE SON WITH A LIVE CHICKEN FOR DINNER IN HIS HAND. WE PHOTOGRAPHED THEM WITH US. ON THE MONDAY WE VISITED THE LAW COURT AS MY WIFE HAD NOT BEEN IN A COURT. THE ACCUSED WERE CHARGED WITH BEING IN POSSESION OF HOUSEBREAKING IMPLEMENTS WHICH LEAD TO A COUPLE OF MONTHS IN THE COOLER . I RECEIVED A SEVERE REPRIMAND TOO AS I WAS CARRYING ALL OUR MONEY IN A MONEYBELT AND MY WIFE COULD NOT FIND ME. I WAS GETTING A HAIR CUT!

PAPUA NEW GUINEA (CONT.)

NEXT DAY WE TOOK OFF FOR KAVIENG IN NEW IRELAND AND AGAIN THERE WERE THOSE BLUE GREEN JEWELS IN THE SEA AS WE PASSED OVER THE CORAL CAYS & ISLANDS. THERE WAS NOT MUCH AT KAVIENG BUT NICE TO HAVE SEEN IT.

THE NEXT PORT OF CALL WAS MANUS ISLAND IN THE ADMIRALTY GROUP. POPULATION 28000 THE NOTICE ON THE AIRPORT SAYS AND ALMOST THAT NUMBER WERE THERE TO MEET THE PLANE. I TOOK A MEX PHOTO OF THE TWO LOVELY P.N.G. HOSTESSES WITH MY WIFE (JUST FOR SAFETY) AND WE MET ONE OF THE GIRLS ON ANOTHER FLIGHT A COUPLE OF WEEKS LATER. MANUS WAS A BIG BASE FOR THE ALLIED FORCES BUT NOW IS NOTHING XER SPECIAL.

FROM MANUS WE TOOK OFF FOR MADANG AND FLEW OVER KARKAR IS.
WHICH XX ALSO HAS AN ACTIVE VOLCANO AND WE COULD SEE RIGHT DOWN
INTO THE CRATER. AFTER ARRIVAL WE WENT TO COLLECT OUR BAGGAGE
ONLY TO FIND IT HAD NOT BEEN ON THE PLANE SO OFF TO THE
SMUGGLERS INN BY TAXI FEELING VERY IRATE. THE MOTEL MANAGER
LENT ME AN ELECTRIC RAZOR (BLUNT) AND ARRANGED FOR THE LOCAL
CHEMIST TO OPEN UP SO WE COULD BUY SOME TOILET GEAR AND I
WAS LUCKY TO GET SOME BLOCK PRESSURE PILLS WITHOUT A SCRIPT
IN VIEW OF WHAT HAD HAPPENED. NEXT WE DUG OUT THE LOCAL
AIKWAYS MANAGER WHO EXPLAINED THE WORDS MANUS AND MADANG
ARE ALL THE SAME TO THE NATIVES SO OUR BAGS WERE PROBABLY BACK
IN MANUS IS, WHICH PROVED TO BE THE CASE JUST A SHORT 600 MILES
SWIN. ANYWAY THEY EVENTUALLY ARRIVED AND WE WERE ABLE TO
CHANGE OUR VERY B.O. CLOTHES.

THE MOTEL MAN WAS EXCELLENT AND THE DRINKING LOUNGE WAS AN OPEN-AIR CONCRETE AFFAIR JUTTING OUT INTO THE SEA AND MATCHING THE COAST CORAL JUST LIKE ONE WOULD EXPECT IN A SMUGGLERS DEN. WE TOOK A TOUR IN A MINIBUS, ONLY THE 2 OF US, TO SEE THE PLANTATIONS AND VILLAGES AND THE DRIVER DIDN'T HAVE MUCH BETWEEN THE EARS AS HE STARTED XMEX TO DRIVE ACROSS A WIDE CREEK TOO DEEP FOR THE BUS SO WE WERE STRANDED IN THE MIDDLE. AFTER A LOT OF FUSS WE GOT OUT OF THE CREEK AND WENT ON OUR WAY.

NEXT DAY WE WENT FOR A CRUISE ON MADANG HARBOUR WHICH WAS LOVELY. IT IS A LARGE STRETCH OF WATER WITH SOME OVERSEAS SHIPPING, BUT THERE ARE XXX LOTS OF SHALLOW PARTS HENCE THE VESSEL WAS A FLAT BOTTOMED SHALLOW DRAUGHT THING WITH A SINGLE CYLINDER DIESEL AND THE CLUTCH HANDLE WAS HELD IN BY THE NATIVES FOOT. WE CRUISED ROUND MANY ISLANDS EX COVERED IN KNOW COCONUT TREES AND NATIVE VILLAGES. STOPPED TO VIEW THE CORAL WHICH COULD BE SEEN CLEARLY THROUGH THE CLEAR STILL WATER - QUITE BEAUTIFUL. THE DRIVER SAW A FISH SO GOT HIS SPEAR AND CAUGHT IT FIRST TRY. THEN WE CRUISED TO A SMALL ISLAND WHERE THE QUEEN WAS TAKEN TO LUNCH IN A HUT WITH PALM LEAF THATCHED ROOF AND NO SIDES, MET THE NATIVE MAN & WOMAN WHO WERE HER HOSTS. SPENT 20c BUYING A COWRIE SHELL AFTER MUCH BARGAINING. WE SAW INSIDE THE HOUSE OF THE COUPLE AND IT WAS DARK AND DINGY, FULL OF XMX SMOKE FROM THEIP COOKING FIRE ON A PIECE OF TIN IN THE CENTRE OF THE FLOOR. SOME OF THE OTHER PASSENGERS WENT FOR A SWIM. I HAD TO BE CARRIED DOWN AND UP A NARROW GANG PLANK HOPING THE NATIVE WOULD NOT DROP ME. THEN WE WENT BACK TO THE INN FOR A LOVELY FRESH FISH DINNER AND A DROP OF LUBRICATION. NEXT DAY WE WENT UP TO THE TOWNSHIP WITH A PLANTER AND HIS WIFE IN THEIR RANGE ROVER AND EN ROUTE MX THEY TOLD US WHAT TO SEE ETC. WE SAW A HUGE FIG TREE WITH LITERALLY HUNDRED OF FLYING FOXES HANGING FROM THE BRANCHES FAST ASLEEP. THE PLANTER TOLD US HE WAS OPENING UP A FURTHER 50 ACRES OF PLANTATIONS AND AND CONTINUALLY UNCOVERED SKELETONS FROM WORLD WAR 11.

OUR NEXT FLIGHT WAS TO LAE AND WE KXX FLEW OVER THE FINNESTAIRE RANGES AND ALONG THE RAMU VALLEY PAST NADZAB BEFORE LANDING, AS ALWAYS BEFORE A SEA OF FACES IN COLOURFUL OUTFITS. LAE IS NO LONGER A STRETCH OF BROKEN BUILDINGS AND SMASHED COCONUT TREES AS THE AUTHORITIES HAVE BUILT A MODERN CITY NEARER THE AIRPORT BUT THE HUMIDITY IS STILL THERE. WE VISITED THE WAR CEMETARY NEX AND ORCHID GARDENS AND WE ASKED OUR DRIVER TO COME BACK FOR US AT A CERTAIN TIME BUT HE FORGOT! THERE WERE NATIVES EVERYWHERE AND FORTUNATELY A WHITE WOMAN DROVE UP AND OFFERED TO DRIVE US IN TO THE CITY. ON THE WAY SHE TOLD US WE WERE FOOLISH TO GO THERE ALONE AS IT WAS A NOTED BAD AREA FOR ATTACHKS ON WHITE PEOPLE. ANYWAY WE FINISHED LOOKING THE CITY OVER IN 3 DAYS AND AGAIN BACKED OUR BAGS.

PAPUA NEW GUINEA (CONT.)

THE PLACES WE HAD VISITED ON THE TRIP SO FAR HAD ALL BEEN COASTAL WITH COAST TYPE NATIVES BOTH PAPUAN AND NEW GUINEAN SOME OF WHOM HAVE TAKEN ON SOME OF THE WHITE MAN'S HABITS OF LAZINESS AND STEALING, EUROPEAN DRESS ETC. ALSO THE PAPUAN HAVE BUSHY FUZZY HAIR WHILE THE NEW WMM GUINEANS HAVE SHORE CLOSE CUT HAIR.

WE WERE ABOUT TO LEAVE THE LOWLANDS FOR THE HIGH COUNTRY AND OUR FIRST STOP WAS GOROKA IN THE BISMARK RANGES. UNFORTUNETELY IT WAS CLOUDY WHEN WE TOOK OFF FROM LAE BUT WE WAW THE LONG CONCRETE BRIDGE ACROSS THE GREAT MARKHAM RIVER. WE USED TO CROSS IN LANDING BARGES! WE FLEW A WINDING COURSE ROUND MOUNTAIN PEAKS AND FINALLY CIRCLED COROKA WHICH XX LOOKED VERY PICTURESQUE WITH ALL RODAS AND TRACKS MEETING AT THE TOWN. THE AIRPORT IS RIGHT IN THE CENTRE OF THE TOWN AND ONCE AGAIN THE SEA OF BLACK FACES SMILING WITH GREAT WHITE TEETH. HAD NOTICED A LOT OF COLOUR FROM THE AIR AND WHEN WE REACHED OUR HOTEL WE FOUND OUT WHAT IT WAS - THE HOTEL EXXE BATH TOWELS SPREAD ON THE GRASS TO DRY. BEING SUNDAY ALL WAS SHUT SO WE STROLLED AROUND LOOKING AT THE SHOPS. WE SAW SOME BEAUTIFUL YOUNG WOMEN, LONG AND SLIM AND SCANTILY CLAD BUT THEIR BEADS AND BANGLES WERE VERY COLOURFUL. THE MEN WORE JUST AS LITTLE AND BOTH MEN AND WOMEN WERE SMOTHERED IN PIG FAT WHICH MADE THEIR BODIES SHINE AND APPARENTLY WAS TO HELP THEM KEEP WARM. WE WANTED TO SEE THE NATIVE HOME INDUSTRIES AND THEIR WEAVING SO WE WENT TO THE POLICE STATION FOR INFORMATION BUT THE NATIVE POLICE XX DID NOT APPEAR TO UNDERSTAND. SO WE WALKED BACK TOWARDS OUR PUB AND STOPPED TO PHOTOGRAPH A MEMORIAL TO COMMISSIONER IAN DOWNS, THE AUTHOR, WHO SUPERVISED THE EXMXXXM CONSTRUCTION OF THE CENTRAL DISTRICT HIGHLAND ROAD FROM LAE TO MT. HAGEN. SUDDENLY WITH A CLOUD OF DUST AND SQUEELING BRAKES A LONG WHEEL BASE TOYOTA LAND CRUISER STOPPED BESIDE US WITH TWO GRINNING NATIVE POLICEMAN. THEY SAID THEY THOUGHT THEY NOW UNDERSTOOD WHAT WE WANTED TO SEE AND IT TURNED WMY OUT THAT THE DRIVER CAME FROM AN AREA THAT HAD A WEAVING MILL. WITH A DOUBLE SIZE GRIN HE SAID "HOP IN" AND WE FOUND OURSELVES IN A PADDY-WAGON THOUGH THERE WERE NO PRISONERS IN THE CAGE BEHIND US. OFF WE TORE ABOUT 60MPH FOR 8 MILES UP AND DOWN HILLS, ROUND CORNERS SCATTERING CHOOKS AND NATIVES.

WHEN WE REACHED THE MILL IT WAS CLOSED (SUNDAY) BUT AN OLD NATIVE WHO LOOKED 80 HAD A KEY SO AFTER A PARLEY WITH THE RXX POLICE HE OPENED THE DISPLAY HUT WHICH WAS A CIRCULAR PLAITED WALL AND THATCHED ROOF AFFAIR. THERE WERE SOME VERY NICE WOVEN FLOOR RUGS, SHAWLS, COATS, AND BAGS ETC. WE COULDN'T DO LESS THAN BUY SOMETHING SO MY XX WIFE SELECTED A SHOULDER BAG AND SOME TABLE MATS ALL FROM PURE N.Z. WOOL. THEN INTO THE POLICE WAGON AGAIN FOR AN EQUALLY HAIRY DRIVE BACK. LADS OFFERED TO DRIVE US ROUND NEXT DAY IF WE COULDN'T FIND TRANSPORT, BUT, THE NEXT DAY SHOPS WERE OPEN AND WE FOUND THE H.Q. OF THE COTTAGE INDUSTRIES AND AS LUCK WOULD HAVE IT THE HEAD WOMAN. SHE WAS FROM VANCOUVER UNIVERSITY WHO HAD BEEN SENT OUT TO START THE INDUSTRIES, LIKED THE PEOPLE AND, THE AREA SO HAD STAYED ANOTHER 4 YEARS ESTABLISHING MORE MILLS. ANYWAY SHE TOLD US SHE WAS ON HER WAY TO ANOTHER MILL WITH SOME LATHS AND WELCOMED US TO BE HER PASSENGERS. OFF WE WENT ABOUT MORE WEAVING. THE NATIVES ARE GOOD CRACTSMEN AS EVERYTHING IS HANDMADE AND IS AN EXTENSION OF THEIR NATIVE WEAVING IN THE VILLAGES OF GRASSES, PALMS ETC., THE LADY DECIDED SHE WAS THIRSTY SO DROVE INTO THE VILLAGE WHERE THERE WAS A TINY STORE. JUST AS WE GOT THERE WE WERE GREETED BY TWO TRIBES WHO HAD BEEN FIGHTING THE DAY BEFORE AND WERE GETTING THEMSELVES WORKED UP FOR A "PAY-BACK" FIGHT AS ONE TRIBE HAD A MAN KILLED (WE SAW THE WIDOW WITH HER FACE PLASTERED WITH WHITE CLAY). THEIR HUGE BOWS AND ARROWS WERE QUITE FRINGTENING BUT THE WOMAN DRIVING US WAS KNOWN TO THEM AND SHE TOLD US WE WERE SAFE. SHE VOLUNTEERED TO SPEND THE REST OF THE DAY WITH US TO SHOW US AROUND BUT FIRST WE WENT TO LUNCH WHERE WE MET A CHAP WHO HAD BEEN THE BOSS OF A MAN WHO MARRIED A NIECE OF MINE - SHE WAS A CHEMIST AT GOROKA AND HE A VET. AFTER LUNCH WE WENT TO SEE OVER THE HOSPITAL AS MY WIFE IS A NURSING SISTER AND IT WAS MOST KN PRIMATIVE. MOTHERS LAY ON TORN DIRY MATTRESSES WITH THEIR SICK BABIES, NO OTHER BDECLOTHES AND THE SMELL... I HAD ENOUGH BUT MY WIFE CONTINUED ON A FULL TOUR OF THE HOSPITAL. FINALLY WE SAID GOOD BYE AND FELT CURSELVES LUCKY TO HAVE HAD SUCH A NICE GUIDE.

AS OUR NEXT VISIT WAS TO MT. HAGEN IN THE HXEXXM HIGHLANDS WE THOUGHT IT WOULD BE BETTER TO GO BY ROAD AND BEGBENEATHOUSE THE CLOUDS TO SEE THINGS. WE GOT THE HOTEL TO MAKE US A BOXED LUNCH AND SET OFF FOR THE BUS STATION JUST ACROSS THE ROAD. THE BUS WAS A TOYOTA COASTER IN FAIRLY GOOD XX CONDITION AND BEXEX BESIDES THE DRIVER THERE WERE A FARE COLLECTOR/INTERPRETER A SCOTSMAN WITH A GERMAN WIFE ON THEIR RETIREMENT. A FRENCH COUPLE FROM TAHITIJ A MANGAND WIFE FROM LOSGANGELESS (SEEING 10.1) IF THE TRIP WOULD BE GOOD FOR TOURING AND WE TWO. THE DRIVER TOOK OFF THREE TIMES BUT EACH TIME FORGOT SOMETHING AND WENT BACK TO THE DEPOT BUT WE STARTED 30 MINUTES LATE. BEFORE WE KNEW IT WE XX WERE BACK IN THE VILLAGE OF YESTERDAY WHERE THE TRIBES WERE FIGHTING AND OUR BUS STOPPED TO TAKE ON SOME GOODS. UP THE ROAD CAME HUNDREDS OF NATIVES ARMED WITH BOWS. ARROWS AND SPEARS CHANTING AND DANCING AND WE PUT OUR WINDOW THEN FOLLOWED THE POLICE WAGONS EACH WITH 12 POLICE. THREE WAGONS CHASED ONE TRIBE AND THREE THE ORNER SO KEPT THE PEACE AT LEAST TILL WE GOT UNDER WAY AGAIN.

THE ROAD CLIMBED STEADILY TO 8000 FEET DVER THE DALU PASS AND XKKXXXX WAS VERY XXX SCENIC. EN ROUTE WE CAME TO CHIMBU AND STOPPED FOR OUR PACKED LUNCH AND A CUP OF TEA. DURING THE JOURNEY THE SCOT AND GERMAN WERE SITTING ON OPPOSITE SIDES OF THE BUS AND WERE SEPARATED BY NATIVES WHO JOINED THE BUS FREQUENTLY IF THEY HAD ENOUGH MX MONEY FOR THE FARE BUT THEY WERE SHUT OUT IF NOT. ANYWAY THE SCOT AND WIFE EXCHANGED SANDWICHES AND BANANAS XXXX ACROSS THE SMELLY NATIVES AND BY CHIMBU HAD EATEN EVERYTHING THEY HAD. WE HAD TOO MUCH IN OUR LUNCH BOX SO THEY WELCOMED IT AND WERE QUITE A NICE COUPLE REALLY. CHIMBU WAS A NICE MOUNTAIN VILLAGE WITH AN AIRSTRIP AND TO LAND THE AIRSTRIP AND TO LAND THE AIRCRAFT HAD TO SPIRAL DOWN. TO TAKE OFF THE PLANES RUN STRAIGHT OFF THE END OF THE STRIP AND WERE AIRBORNE AS THE MOUNTAIN JUST DROPPED 100 XXXX STRAIGHT DOWN!! AFTER LUNCH OUR BUS STRUGGLED ON ROUND NUMEROUS LANDSLIDES AND WE HAD TO REVERSE OUT OF ONE WHICH WAS A BIT HAIRY. BAXTER BROS. WHO ARE BUILDING THE NEW HORNIBROOK HIGHWAY BRIDGE NEAR BRISBANE APPARENTLY MAINTAIN THE ROAD AND THEY HAVE SOME HUGE MACHINERY ALL MODERN AND RUN BY THE NATIVES. I THINK WHITES DO THE MAINTENANCE. AFTER REACHING THE CREST OF THE MXX MOUNTAIN WE TRAVELLED ALONG AN

OPEN PLATEAU WITH SURROUNDING MOUNTAINS AND STOPPED TO LET A BOY OFF AT AN S.D.A. SCHOOL WHILE HIS UNCLE MET HIS AND PAID HIS FARE. THE KID HAD A VERY SHARP TOMAHWWK AS PART OF HIS SCHOOL LUGGAGE. THE BUS WAS SURROUNDED BY GRINNING BOYS AND GIRLS AND ONE MOTHER WAS BLOWING BUDBLEGUM WHILE BREAST FEEDING HER INFANT AND POSED FOR MY WIFE TO PHOTOGRAPH. ON WE WENT AND SUDDENLY THE DRIVER STOPPED BESIDE A PRIMATIVE NATIVE WEEDING GROUP TO LET US HAVE A LOOK AND TAKE PHOTOS. THE BRIDE WAS NOT HANSOME WITH A RED PAINTED NOSE, PAINTED DESIGNS ALL OVER HER AND A CATS FUR HANGING TAIL DOWN BETWEEN HER BOSOM PLUS A FEW BITS OF STRING TIED ROUND HER WAIST. THE INTERESTING PART WAS HER BRIDE PRICE WHICH KMMXXXX CONSISTED OF ABOUT 10 BAMBOO POLES WITH SLITS BETWEEN EACH NODULE. INTO EACH SLIT WAS PUSHED PAPER MONEY AND I CALCULATED THERE MUST HAVE BEEN \$2000 AT LEAST. AL THE PARTY WAS DRESSED UP AND WAS APPARENTLY HAVING A GOOD TIME. A NATIVE ON THE BUS TOLD ME THAT THE SAME BRIDE DOWN AT THE COAST WOULD COST ANYWAY IT WAS SOMETHING WORTH SEEING. WE CARRIED ON AND CAME TO THE TEA PLANTATIONS AND IT WAS ICKING TIME. WE THOUGHT THE PNG GROWN TEA WAS SUPERB FOR TASTE AND AROMA AND WE HAVE BEEN ORDERING IT IN 161b XXXXX LCTS AT ABOUT 60c A 为1b FOR USE IN MELBOURNE, DIRECT FROM THE FACTORY.

WHEN WE REACHED THE OUTSKIRTS OF MT. HAGEN WE FOUND THAT NONE OF THE OTHER THREE COUPLES HAD ARRANGED ACCOMMODATION AND COULD NOT AFFORD A HOTEL. SO THE DRIVER TOOK US ALL ROUND THE FEW MISSION HOSTELS AND THEY ALL FINISHED UP SLEEPING TOGETHER WHEN SOME KXXXX GIRLS WERE MOVED OUT TO MAKE ROOM. WE WENT ON TO OUR HOTEL WHICH WAS VERY COMFORTABLE WITH EXCELLENT MEALS. WE SPENT 23 DAYS LOOKING AROUNG AND FOUND THE SHOPS QUITE INTERESTING ESPECIALLY THE CHINESE ONES. WE HAD DIFFICULTY IN CHASING ONE PERSISTENT HAWKER IN THE MAIN STREET WITH PIG TUSKS AND CARVINGS BUT FOR 10 CENTS GOT HIM TO POSE FOR A SNAP. HE WAS ALMOST NAKED WITH A BIT OF STRING ROUND HIS WAIST AND DOWN FRONT AND A SMALL BUNCH OF LEAVES CALLED "ARSE GRASS" AT THE REAR AND A WICKED KNIFE. THE WOMEN WHO HAVE BABIES CARRY A MKX BLACK UMBRELLA TO KEEP THE SUN OFF AND THEY WERE VERY FASCINATED AS MY WIFE HAD A WHITE UMBRELLA WHICH STOOD OUT LIKE A MUSHROOM IN THE NATIVE MARKETS. WE WENT THERE ON THE

PAPUA NEW GUINEA (CONT.)

FINAL DAY TO XMX BUY SOME FRESH GREEN VEGIES TO TAKE BACK TO MORESBY NEXT MORNING. WE PASSED THE FIRE EXXX BRIGADE ON THE WAY TO MARKET AND STOPPED TO ASK THE NATIVE THE EXACT WAY. SHORTLY AFTER WHILE WE WERE LOOKING AROUND THIS CHAP TURNED UP BESIDE US WITH A RICE BAG FOR US TO CARRY OUR PURCHASES AS THE STALL HOLDERS JUST HAND ONE A LETTUCE, HANDFUL OF BEANS A CABBAGE ETC., AND HE NOTICED THAT WE WERE TOURISTS AND HAD NO BAG TO CARRY THINGS. THEN HE LEFT US AND WENT BACK TO THE STATION AND TRIED TO GET US A CAB BUT TO NO AVAIL. SO EXX WE STARTED TO WALK THE MILE BACK TO THE PUB WHEN AN EMPTY BUS CAME ALONG. WE FLAGGED HIM DOWN AND ASKED HIM TO TAKE US TO THE HOTEL WHICH HE DID WITHOUT PAYMENT SO WE GAVE HIM THE CABBAGE WHICH WAS TOO HEAVY ANYWAY.

NEXT MORN WE TOOK OFF FOR MORESBY AND AGAIN WENT OUT TO MY SISTER'S HOUSE FOR ABOUT 2 WEEKS, AFTER A MOST INTERESTING $2\frac{1}{2}$ WEEKS TOURING AROUNG.

WE DECIDED TO GO TO XXXX AIR NEW GUINEA TO THANK THE LADY WHO MADE OUR ARRANGEMENTS AND OF COURSE TOLD HER OF OUR LOST LUGGAGE. SHE TOOK US ALONG TO SEE THE PERSONNEL OFFICER WHO WAS WELL DRESSED, CLEAN AND SPOKE VERY WELL. HE WAS FILLING IN A FORM AND WHEN WE TOLD HIM OUR MELBOURNE ADDRESS HE BECAME FRIENDLY AND TOLD US HE HAD LIVED AT BOX HILL WHILE HE ATTENDED CAMBERWELL GRAMMAR SCHOOL FOR 6 YEARS. IT IS A PITY THERE ARE NOT MORE NATIVES WITH IS OBVIOUS EDUCATION NOW THAT P.N.G. IS INDETENDANT!

WE WERE SORRY TO HAVE TO COME BACK REALLY EX FOR WE HAD A MOST INTERESTING TIME BUT P.N.G. IS A BIT IFFEY JUST NOW AND WILL REMAIN SO TILL THE INDIGENIES BECOME USED TO INDEPENDENCE. IT TOOK 4 OF THEM TO CASH A TRAVELLERS CHEQUE FOR ME ONE DAY PLUS OODLES OF WRONG FORMS. STILL I'M SURE THEY WILL LEARN IN TIME.
