### HANDY HUMBER HINTS

Loose and unsightly bonnet insulation on the Series Model cars can be rectified by using fibreglass or bronze "Fly Wire" Remove the "tatty" piece and using this as a sample a new piece can be cut and refitted into position.

The complete front seat assembly from the series model Humbers is interchangeable with the front seat of the Mk 11 & MK 111 cars.
