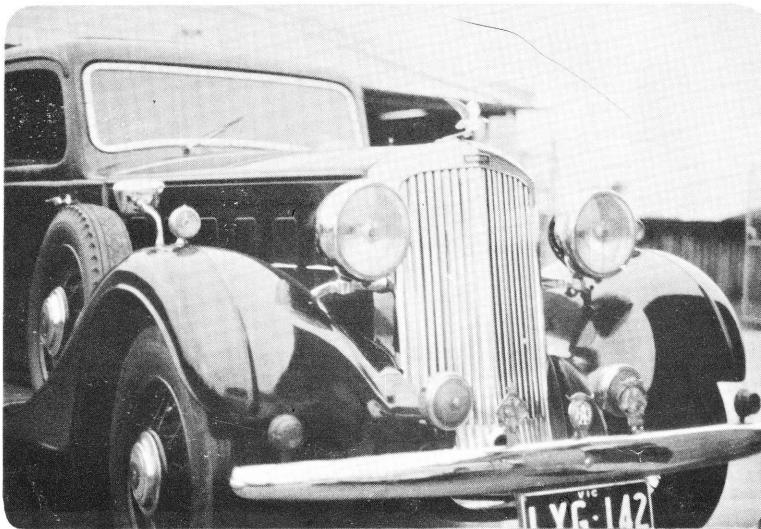

SPARE PARTS

A SUB-COMMITTEE WAS FORMED THIS YEAR TO ASSIST BOB KENNEDY WITH THE CLUB STOCK OF SPARE PARTS. GREG LAMING WILL CONTINUE TO ORGANISE THE MK MODEL PARTS AND HE WILL BE ASSISTED BY LAURIE MOBILIA. BOB KENNEDY WILL LOOK AFTER THE SERIES MODEL PARTS WITH ASSISTANCE FROM RAY EASTON.

OUR CARS ARE BECOMING INCREASINGLY HARDER TO KEEP ON THE ROADS NOW THAT PARTS ARE BECOMING HARDER TO GET AND GOOD MECHANICAL SERVICE IS EVEN HARDER TO OBTAIN. THE CLUB HOPES THAT IT CAN BUILD UP OUR STOCK OF SPARES TO SUCH AN EXTENT THAT RECONDITIONED PARTS CAN BE OBTAINED BY MEMBERS ON A CHANGE-OVER BASIS EG. STARTER MOTORS, GENERATORS, CYL HEADS ETC. WITH A SERVICE SUCH AS THIS THE REQUIRED PART CAN BE PICKED UP AND FITTED BY YOURSELF OR ALTERNATIVELY BY YOUR GARAGE PROPRIETOR, THIS MIGHT END THE LOCAL GARAGE MECHANICS EXCUSE OF "WAITING FOR PARTS", AND THE USUAL EXCESSIVE CHARGES BECAUSE THE CAR IS A HUMBER.

SPARE PARTS CONT.

AT PRESENT THE SPARES CARRIED ARE FROM THE SMALLEST ITEM TO COMPLETE LONG MOTORS. THE EFFICIENCY OF OUR SPARE PARTS SERVICE WILL BE CLOSELY LINKED WITH THEIR SALES, SO IF WE CAN SELL MORE PARTS THIS MONEY CAN THEN BE PLOUGHED BACK INTO THE PURCHASE OF RECONDITIONED AND POSSIBLY EVEN NEW PARTS FOR FUTURE USE.
